Faculty

Kerri Sanders (Education Director / Day Camp Director / Acting Instructor) has been teaching, directing, acting, etc. at New Stage Theatre since 2011. Some of her favorite acting credits include *A Time to Kill*, *A Christmas Carol*, *One Man Two Guvnors*, *Other Desert Cities*, *The Great Gatsby*, *The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe*, *Grapes of Wrath*, *Dracula*, and *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. Sanders graduated from Belhaven University with a BA in Theatre. Her directing credits include *The Selfish Giant*, *The Taming of the Shrew*, *Walk! Don't Ride: A Celebration of the Fight for Equality*, *Twelfth Night*, and *Much Ado About Nothing*. Sanders is also the host of the Mississippi Public Broadcasting series *Job Hunter*.

Chris Roebuck (Broadway Camp Show Director, Acting Instructor) graduated from Mississippi College with a B.A. in history. He taught for two years at Madison Central High School, where among other responsibilities he assisted with the Drama Club. In addition to the education touring shows, his directing credits include *Goodnight, Moon*, *The Cat in the Hat*, *The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe*, *The Weir*, *Lilly's Purple Plastic Purse*, *A Christmas Carol*, and *Dead Man's Cell Phone* at New Stage and *American Buffalo* and *Dinner with Friends* with Fondren Theatre Workshop.

Harlan Zackery, Jr. (Broadway Camp Show Music Director / Music Instructor) is Director of Orchestra, Assistant Director of Choral Activities and Keyboard Studies Coordinator at Jackson State University. He also serves as Director of Music at Aldersgate United Methodist Church. His New Stage credits include *The Robber Bridegroom*, *Shrek*, *The Musical*, *Hairspray*, *Mahalia: A Gospel Musical*, *Breaking Up Is Hard To Do*, *I Love You, You're Perfect*, *Now Change*, *The Fantasticks* and a host of others.

Both camps also feature master classes taught by seasoned theatre professionals and New Stage veterans. Past master classes have included Stage Combat taught by Danny Dauphin, Improv taught by Deenie Castleberry, Film and TV taught by Rus Blackwell and Storytelling taught by Diane Williams.

Camp participants will receive instruction in acting, improvisation, stage movement, musical theatre, dance, voice and diction, and auditioning. Students will perform in a showcase for invited friends and family on the final day of camp.

*Greek Tragedy** rising 6th-12th graders

Cost: \$225 before May 1st, \$275 after May 1st

What: Two weeks of instruction and rehearsals taught and directed by Education Director Kerri Sanders and other seasoned theatre professionals culminating in a final production for invited friends and family. Camp participants will receive instruction in acting, stage movement, and stage combat with an emphasis on classical literature, especially Elizabethan and Greek.

When: Monday-Friday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., June 5th-16th



Broadway Camp • June 19th-July 16th

*Once on This Island, Jr.** rising 6th-12th graders

Cost: \$450 before May 1st, \$500 after May 1st

What: Four weeks of theatre instruction taught by Education Director Kerri Sanders and other seasoned theatre veterans. Students will be introduced to all the elements of theatre production in daily classes. The culmination of the camp will be a fully-produced production presented for four performances on New Stage's main stage. Camp participants will receive instruction from camp staff in acting, improvisation, stage movement, musical theatre, dance, voice and diction, and audition technique, and production elements.
