**Sharon Miles** (Education Director / Day Camp Director / Acting Instructor) received her theatre training from the University of Southern Mississippi. Miles has been working as a professional actress for almost twenty years and has worked as a contracted guest artist in the New Stage Theatre Education Department since 2011. Most recently, she served as the music director for the First Stages Camp production of *Lion King Kids*. Miles truly believes that helping a child discover one thing that they are good at can build their self-esteem and that confidence can spill over into every aspect of their lives. Discovering theatre at a young age was a game changer in her life and she wants to offer that same experience to students throughout the state of Mississippi. Some of her favorite theatrical roles at New Stage include: Stage Manager is *Our Town*, Gwen in *A Time to Kill*, Fannie Lou Hamer in *All the Way*, Miss Nelson in *Miss Nelson is Missing*, Cassandra in *Vanya, Sonia, Masha and Spike*, and Alex the Lion in *Madagascar the Musical*.

**Chris Roebuck** (Broadway Camp Show Director, Acting Instructor) graduated from Mississippi College with a B.A. in history. He taught for two years at Madison Central High School, where among other responsibilities he assisted with the Drama Club. In addition to the education touring shows, his directing credits include *Goodnight, Moon, The Cat in the Hat, The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe, The Weir, Lilly's Purple Plastic Purse, A Christmas Carol*, and *Dead Man's Cell Phone* at New Stage and *American Buffalo* and *Dinner with Friends* with Fondren Theatre Workshop.

**Cost:** Early Bird Tuition (before May 1)—\$250; Regular tuition—\$300

Two weeks of theatre instruction taught and directed by Education Director Sharon Miles and other seasoned theatre professionals. The camp will include creative dramatic games, structured improvisations, and will culminate in a showcase performance for invited friends and family. Camp participants will receive instruction in acting, improvisation, stage movement, musical theatre, dance, voice and diction, and auditioning.

Two weeks of instruction and rehearsals taught and directed by Education Director Sharon Miles and other seasoned theatre professionals culminating in a final production for invited friends and family. Camp participants will receive instruction in acting, stage movement, and stage combat with an emphasis on classical literature.

**Cost:** Early Bird Tuition (before May 1)—\$475; Regular Tuition—\$525

Four weeks of theatre instruction taught and directed by Resident Teaching Artist Chris Roebuck and other seasoned theatre veterans. Students will be introduced to all the elements of theatre production in daily classes. The culmination of the camp will be a fully-produced production presented for four performances on New Stage's main stage. Camp participants will receive instruction in acting, improvisation, stage movement, musical theatre, dance, voice and diction, and auditioning.
