Brought to our stage thanks to our Eudora Welty New Plays Series, this hilarious spin on modern motherhood will have you laughing, crying, and glad you paid a visit to *Morningside*. *Recommended for ages 16+*

Topher Payne, a native of Kosciusko, began his theatre career here at New Stage as a scene shop intern in 1997. He went on to tour with New Stage's Arts-in-Education program, and his first attempt at playwriting was staged in The Hewes Room. Since moving to Atlanta in 1999, he has authored more than twenty plays, which have been produced around the world. Payne was a 2017 Lambda Literary Award nominee for *Perfect Arrangement*, which was also awarded the 2014 Osborn Award by the American Theatre Critics Association. *Perfect Arrangement* had its Off-Broadway premiere in 2015, and is one of three of his titles published by Samuel French. His other works include *Swell Party, Tokens of Affection, Let Nothing You Dismay, Evelyn in Purgatory*, and the upcoming *You Enjoy Myself*. He began writing for television in 2016, and has scripted four films for The Hallmark Channel. Highlights of his directing career include *The Foreigner* at The Hangar Theatre in New York, *Trash* at The Process Theatre in Atlanta, and *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* at The State Theatre of Georgia, The Springer Opera House. Payne is this year's inductee into The Georgia Theatre Hall of Fame.

"*Morningside* explores the challenges Southern women face in 2018," says Director/Playwright Topher Payne. "It's the conflict of tradition versus progress, of social expectations versus personal desires, of duty to family – whatever her particular definition of family is – versus the need for individual identity. That sounds like a lot to tackle in one story, but I think that's really the point: these are the choices they're dealing with every day."

"I am so pleased that we are finally producing one of Topher Payne's plays on the main stage at New Stage Theatre. A fully staged production of a Payne play at New Stage is long overdue and *Morningside* is the perfect choice to kick off our "The Power of Place" 53rd Season," says Artistic Director Francine Thomas Reynolds. "Not only did Topher begin his playwriting journey at New Stage, he is a master at creating roles for women. He comes from our place - Mississippi and New Stage - and he skillfully writes about the south's uniqueness as a place of family conflict, comedy, tears, and laughter."
