#### New Stage Theatre's Season 54: *The Literary Party*

#### Dear Theatre Lover,

You are invited to The Literary Party! The power of literature comes alive during New Stage Theatre's 54th season, which features comedies, mysteries, and drama with plots that highlight prose and poetry, and captivating musicals and plays adapted from exciting, classic, and beloved books. The 2019-2020 lineup includes award-winning works, regional premieres, a new groundbreaking drama, and an epic musical.

The Literary Party season begins with Into the Breeches!, a vibrant and big hearted comedy by George Brant. In this hilarious new play, set in 1942, a group of women are determined to mount the Shakespeare classic Henry V while the theatre's director and leading men are off fighting WWII overseas. *Into the Breeches!* will be the first of the season's three regional premieres. It will be followed by another premiere, the thrilling mystery, Agatha Christie's Murder on the Orient Express. Ken Ludwig's adaptation of Christie's timeless classic takes you on a suspenseful, thrilling ride aboard the

Obie Award-winning playwright Dominique Morisseau's *Pipeline* provides a look at the school-to-prison pipeline in a compelling portrait presented against a backdrop of landmark African-American literature. With profound compassion and lyricism, the deeply moving story of *Pipeline* raises important questions about race, class, and parental duty as it brings an urgent conversation powerfully to the fore in our third regional premiere.

Following that will be the Tony Award-winning Best Play The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time. Mark Haddon's bestselling novel is brought to the stage in this dazzling, inventive play about the wonders of life as a unique young man goes on a quest to solve a mystery

Closing the season will be the ultimate musical for our time, *Ragtime*. Based on one of the most successful novels of its era, E.L. Doctorow's Ragtime paints a powerful portrait of the American Dream that awakens the heart and captivates the soul. With a Tony Award-winning book and musical score written by Terrence McNally and with music and lyrics by Stephen Flaherty and Lynn Ahrens, Ragtime is a must-see musical masterpiece bursting with showstopping splendor and unbridled passion.

Amazing adaptations will be offered as extras in the season at discounted ticket prices for subscribers, including the traditional holiday favorite A Christmas Carol. The endearing characters Charles Dickens depicts in his yuletide classic create a strong emotional bond with the reader that has survived for decades and Michael Wilson's play adaptation does the same for theatre audiences. In January and February, Roald Dahl's much-loved book will burst into life on the stage in *Matilda the Musical*, a special production guaranteed to delight audiences of all ages.

Some stories can be adapted from one form to another and, in doing so, introduce an entirely new perspective. Stage adaptions of literature, though, hold the unique power to bring our favorite stories to life by bridging two of society's major cultural platforms. New Stage Theatre has a commitment to the words on the page, to authentic storytelling, and to extraordinary talent. 

New Stage's education program is designed to introduce young Mississippians to live theatre of substance and imagination. Included are School Fest Matinees of mainstage shows, a touring program, workshops for both teachers and students, acting classes, summer camps, and an apprenticeship program.

The 2019-20 schedule of shows and programs offer several opportunities for youth involvement. New Stage Theatre's touring productions and matinee productions played for more than 26,000 people during the last school year. The touring productions travel to schools, libraries, and community centers statewide. The touring shows for the 2019-20 year will be a modern take on the classic tale *The Ugly Duckling* for elementary age students, and If Not Us, Then Who: Freedom Rides to Freedom Summer, a play with music featuring pivotal moments in the Civil Rights movement for middle and high school students. An abridged production of William Shakespeare's Macbeth will also be available for middle and high school students.
