Marmee March: The girls' mother. Female/45 to 55/Eb3 – Eb5 Meg March: The world-weary, yet hopeful, oldest sister who yearns for a great life. Female/21-25/Bb3-B5 Jo March: Our story's protagonist. Passionate, adventurous, and brave. Female/18-23/E3-A5 Beth March: The second youngest sister who tragically dies of Scarlet Fever. Female/17-21/G3-G5 Amy March: The youngest, most energetic sister. Female/14-18/F#3-Gb5 Aunt March: A formidable matron and great-aunt to the March sisters. Female/45 to 60/E3-F#5 Mr. Laurence: Laurie's grandfather and the March Family neighbor. Male/60-70/C3–D4 Mr. John Brooke: Laurie's tutor and a rather stiff man. Male/30 to 40/E3-G4 Laurie Laurence: The boy-next-door with considerable charm. Male/18 to 23/Bb2-Bb4 Professor Bhaer: German Professor who exemplifies proper manners. Male/35-45/G2-G4 Mrs. Kirk: The New York boarding house proprietress that lodges Jo and Professor Bhaer. Ensemble - 4 to 7 actors who also portray the "Operatic Tragedy" Players including Clarissa, Braxton, Roderigo, Troll, Hag, Knight and Roderigo II
