New Stage Unframed Series presents *Sunset Baby* By Dominique Morisseau

JACKSON—Jackson, Mississippi – The Unframed Series at New Stage Theatre presents *Sunset Baby* by Dominique Morriseau February 24th-25th 2023 at 7:30 p.m and February 26th 2023 at 2pm. Tickets may be purchased online at newstagetheatre.com for \$10 until February 24th, 2023 at 5pm. If there is seating available, tickets may also be purchased for \$15 half hour before each show. *Sunset Baby* is a 90 minute show with no intermission. The performances are staged at New Stage's Warehouse Theatre, which is located at 1000 Monroe Street in the Belhaven Heights neighborhood. *Sunset Baby* contains STRONG ADULT LANGUAGE, CONTENT AND THEMES AND IS FOR MATURE AUDIENCES ONLY.

Sunset Baby, directed by Marquita Levy and Ashia Benford, is an energized, witty, and vibrant look where personal and political collide. Written in 2012, Sunset Baby revolves around the reunion of a former Black revolutionary with his estranged daughter, Nina. At the center of this fraught and broken relationship are the now historically significant and valuable letters Nina's mother wrote to her father while he was in jail. From one of the most exciting young voices in the American theatre, this dynamic play about fathers and daughters sears with wit and wisdom and the brutal politics of freedom.

Dominique Morriseau's other works include, *Pipeline*, *Skeleton Crew*, Ain't Too Proud, *Detroit 67*, and *Paradise Blue*. She is the recipient of the MacArthur Fellowship, the Jane Chambers Playwriting Award which recognizes plays created by women that present a feminist perspective and was nominated for a Tony Award for writing Ain't Too Proud becoming the third Black woman to do so. Dominique Morisseau writes plays that carry pieces and shreds and glimpses of people who have raised her, who she loves and cares for fiercely. These pieces of real life, knit together with imagination and fierce love of these people–as well as a desire to carve a space for their stories on the American stage—have defined Morisseau's writing thus far.

Francine Reynolds, the artistic director of New Stage Theatre says, "I am thrilled for several reasons about the Unframed production of *Sunset Baby*. Dominque Morriseau is currently one of the most exciting playwrights creating work for the stage and it is especially exciting that two Unframed acting alums, Marquita Levy and Ashia Benford, are co-directing this complex piece. In their hands, and with the cast and creative team they have assembled, *Sunset Baby* promises to be electrifying and powerful."



The Cast

The cast of *Sunset Baby* includes Destin Benford (Kenyatta), RaKaela Thompson (Nina), and Tim Magee (Damon). Co-Directed by Marquita Levy and Ashia Benford, Levy says, "I hope you're willing to take this journey with us though pain and heartache, which can sometimes be a bit uncomfortable but necessary. This play, complex and dynamic dives into the struggle of each character allowing the audience to be captivated by their stories." Benford adds, "This play takes you on a roller-coaster of emotions from the beginning. Morriseau so beautifully weaves the past and the present creating a dynamic play that asks the question, "Is love a liability?" Levy and Benford are thankful to be working with such a talented cast who is not afraid to immerse themselves into this story.
