DR. STUART ROCKOFF (MS Humanities Council, Executive Director) A native of Texas, Stuart Rockoff received a B.A. in History from Wesleyan University. He earned a M.A. and Ph.D. in American History from the University of Texas at Austin, specializing in immigration, race, and American Jewish history. After 11 years as the Director of the History Department at the Institute of Southern Jewish Life in Jackson, Mississippi, he became the third executive director of the Mississippi Humanities Council in 2013, where he works to develop and support public programs that explore our state's unique history and culture. He was a member of the scholarly review board for both the Museum of Mississippi History and the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum and serves on the board of the Mississippi Book Festival.
