New Stage Theatre, a professional theatre in Jackson, Mississippi, seeks temporary staff on an as-needed basis, which varies throughout the year based on the needs of each production. The Over Hire / On Call production personnel for various shows, work calls, and rental events throughout our season. These are as-needed, project based jobs that vary from show to show and season to season.

The positions are paid on an hourly or weekly basis depending on applicant's availability.

Considering joining our team if:

- You are open to project based work that can last for 1-2 days up to 3-4 weeks.
- You have the flexibility to occasionally work nights and weekends
- You need supplemental income and enjoy a variety of project-based technical theatre jobs.

The **Temporary Scenic Painter** should have basic knowledge of scenic painting and may assist in all aspects of finishing paint treatments including creating and replicating textures and color samples from designs; creating and replicating patterns (i.e. wallpaper patterns) and priming and base coating scenery as needed. The Scenic painter should ability to touch up props and scenery as needed and the ability to be scheduled based on the needs of the production. The paint shop is typically open during day time hours, but additional hours may be scheduled based on the needs of the production. Physical ability to lift 25 lbs desirable.

Pay is \$10 per hour depending on experience

The start date for the Temporary Scenic Painter is August 20 or until filled.
