ACTS OF CREATION BY BRIANNA BARRETT

May 5-7

Thea, an aged actress, has become obsessive about her legacy. Though her wife and all the doctors she's insisted on seeing have told her she's fine, she believes she is dying soon and prepares for her death by writing an Al-generated play and creating an "if you're seeing this, I'm dead" video. When Thea and Reed's adult daughters come to visit for an overlapping Anniversary and Mother's Day Weekend, we see them wrestle not only with Thea's ideas, but with each of their perspectives on what a family means and should look like. Act 2 begins with a tableau of Thea's funeral a few days later. We wonder, along with this complex family, what it means to create and how to honor someone's life alongside the legacy they wished to leave behind.

MAINSTAGE FENCES BY AUGUST WILSON Apr. 18-30

Set against the backdrop of 1950's Pittsburgh, August Wilson's Pulitzer Prize winning drama tells the story of Troy Maxson, a one-time star of the Negro baseball leagues who now works as a garbage man, holding court and expounding on life from the chair in his backyard. Due to his race, Troy was denied his shot at the big league, so when his son Cory wants his own chance to play ball, will Troy's bitterness and resentment threaten to tear their relationship apart? Fences explores the walls we build around ourselves and our loved ones, while also illuminating one family's struggles in a racist society.
